

Sound equipment for hire

Description

The Blizzard Audio Club label has acquired sound equipment in order to organise its own events, but also to rent it out.

It is suitable for both indoor and outdoor events (under weather protection) and can be used for :

- Lives (DJ equipment not supplied)
- Dj-sets (DJ equipment not supplied)
- Concerts (instruments not supplied)

It is composed as follows.

1. Equipment (Hardware)

1. QSC KS-Series KS118 Subwoofer (1x)
2. QSC KW-Series KW153 Loudspeaker (2x)
3. K-M 21460 standard speaker stands (2x)
4. HYPCON COMBI2X15T13 combined cables 2x audio + power 3x2.5mm2 15m (triple plug included) (1x)



5. HYPCON COMBIx15IEC combined cable
ix audio + power IEC 15m (2x)



6. Power cables C13 T12 3m (3x)



7. Double-Jacks cables 10m (4x)



8. Extension cord 220v 10m + 1 extension cord 220v 15m(2x)



9. XLR cables 5m (3x)



2. Duration

The equipment is rented on a daily basis. However, arrangements can be made for half days or longer periods. The rate will be adjusted accordingly (see Point 3).

Hourly rentals are not available.

3. Rates

The basic rental fee is CHF 400 [FOUR HUNDRED FRANCS] per day. Half of this amount must be paid before the equipment is collected. The other half is to be paid upon return of the equipment. Any repair or replacement costs will be added to this (see General Conditions).

General Conditions

As the equipment is still considered to be new, this implies that the hirer accepts that it is in

perfect working order. Whatever the method of transport and/or assembly, the hirer is responsible for the equipment as soon as it leaves the owner. The hirer who transports the equipment himself undertakes to do so in the best conditions. The hirer is advised to insure the rented equipment against all risks (vandalism, theft, natural disasters, physical and material damage, etc.) with his insurance company. All possible taxes, charges, fees, authorizations, insurance, etc. are at the expense of the hirer. The hirer is supposed to be familiar with the operation and handling of the equipment and will therefore be held responsible for any misuse. In no case shall the owner be held responsible for any physical or material damage resulting from the use of the equipment by the hirer who has accepted the perfect working condition of the equipment at the time of hire and signature of the contract concerned. The equipment shall be returned to the same place as it was collected. Any defect, irregularity, or excessive wear in relation to the specified use, noted immediately or during a control prior to future use, shall be charged to the hirer. The equipment to be repaired will be repaired by the owner or any other person with an invoice to be paid by the hirer, if the equipment cannot be repaired or is not returned within one month, it will be considered as missing on return. The missing equipment will be invoiced by means of an additional invoice. Finally, a joint inventory of the equipment and an inventory of accessories and consumables will be drawn up when the equipment is made available to the hirer and will be checked at the end of the rental period. This inventory must be signed by the owner and the hirer.
